Summary

Pursuant to Government Code Section 56133, Commission approval is required for extension of service by local agencies to territory outside the agency's boundaries. This section requires that the public agency apply to LAFCo by resolution on behalf of the landowner. In this case, the City of Redwood City has applied for extension of water and sewer service to a proposed subdivision on Edgewood Road. Water and sewer connections are County of San Mateo conditions of approval for the subdivision. The project area is within the sphere of influence of the City of Redwood City and the City's water service area. Commission approval is recommended.

Staff Report and Recommendation:

This proposal was submitted by resolution of the City of Redwood City as a condition of approval by the San Mateo County Planning Commission for a minor subdivision. The subject area is within the sphere of influence of the City of Redwood City and the City's water service area but is not eligible for annexation because it is not contiguous to the city boundary. Environmental Health reports that the City of Redwood City provides the available water and sewer service in the area and the proposal has no adverse environmental health significance. There are two registered voters in the subject territory.

The proposal is consistent with the City's sphere of influence and with water and sewer service already extended to the area by the City of Redwood City. It is therefore respectfully recommended that the Commission, by motion, approve the proposed request for extension of service and authorize the Executive Officer to send a letter of approval to the City and the property owner.

RESOLUTION OF APPLICATION BY THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY REQUESTING LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION APPROVAL FOR EXTENSION OF SEWER SERVICE OUTSIDE JURISDICTIONAL BOUNDARIES PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 56133

WHEREAS, the City of Redwood City ("City") has provided sewer service to the existing residence at 1340 Edgewood Road, Unincorporated San Mateo County, California (APN 058-030-030), which is outside the City's jurisdictional boundaries but within the City's sphere of influence and the City's sewer service area; and

WHEREAS, the original lot at 1340 Edgewood Road is currently being subdivided into two parcels with one existing residence located on Parcel 1; and

WHEREAS, Development of Parcel 2 will require a new sewer connection and service from the City of Redwood City; and

WHEREAS, the property owner of 1340 Edgewood Road, Unincorporated San Mateo County, California (APN 058-030-030) has requested City sewer service to 1340 Edgewood Road, Unincorporated San Mateo County, Parcel 2; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo is processing an application for proposed subdivision and new single family home that requires sewer service from the City; and

WHEREAS, this project is exempt from State CEQA Guidelines. (Section 15303(d) of Guidelines)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY, AS FOLLOWS,

- 1. That the City Manager or his designee submit an application to the Local Agency Formation Commission requesting approval of an extension of the sewer service outside the City's jurisdictional boundaries but within the City's sphere of influence and the City's sewer service area to 1340 Edgewood Road, Unincorporated San Mateo County, California (APN 058-030-030) pursuant to California Government Code Section 56133 of the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000.
- 2. That the Local Agency Formation Commission of San Mateo County is hereby requested to take proceedings in the manner provided by California Government Code Section 56133.
